Dear Sirs:

We are concerned for the safety of journalist **Edwin Eliseo Paxtor Crisostomo**, who hosts the news program on Chiquimula's local cable television and is the regional correspondent for the national media outlets, Prensa Libre, Noti7 and Radio Cadena Sonora. On July 11, hewas one of the journalists assaulted with machetes by former members of the Civil Defence Patrols (PAC) while hewas filming a demonstration in Chiquimula. Death threats have escalated since July 27 when Pax tor reported the assaults of four youths by plain-clothed agents of the Criminal Investigation Service (SIC) of the National Civil Police (PNC).

More recently, Pax tor reported these intimidations and threats to the Human Rights Ombudsman's Office, who referred them to the local judge:

September 11: an unknown man told him on the phone, "your days are counted, we are going to kill you."

September 12: he was followed by a black four-wheel drive vehicle.

September 15: hew as followed by a red Toy ota Corrolla with tinted windows.

Septembr 16: when his daughters returned home, a man standing near the house made threatening gestures to them.

September 23: anonymous phone caller tried to lure him to an isolated location by saying that a murder had taken place there.

Edw in Pax tor has complained on several occasions to the Departmental Governor of Chiquimula about the SIC harassment. On one occasion, the Department Governor accompanied him to an assignment so that he would not be prevented from taking photographs. The Governor has discussed the situation with members of the SIC who have told him that Edw in Pax tor "...never has anything good to say about them." In early September, Pax tor spoke with the special Attorney for Crimes Against Journalists and Trade Unionists, but the conversation was overheard by a member of the National Civil Police. Since then his work has also been obstructed by members of the PNC other than SIC.

We urge you to:

- > take immediate measures, in accordance with Edwin Paxtor's wishes, to guarantee his safety and that of his family;
- > take immediate measures to guarantee that he can carry out his work as a journalist without obstruction or harassment;
- begin an immediate and thorough investigation into the death threats and other harassment, make the results public and bring those responsible to justice;
