Dear Sirs:

We are outraged at the attack and murder of **Quetzalcoatl Leija Herrera**, Director of the Center for Study and Projects on Integrated Human Development (CEPRODEHI) in Chilpancingo, Guerrero, on May 4. He was attacked by unknown assailants as he walked home. He was an outspoken advocate of LGBT rights. Every June he and his colleagues organized an annual Gay Pride and diversity march in Chilancingo. In previous years he and other CEPRODHEI staff had received telephone death threats warning them not to hold the march. CEPRODHEI had filed complaints with the authorities, and police had provided protection to them during the marches.

Guerrero state police investigating the assassination have reportedly held in custody for two days a friend from the LGBT community who was the last person to see Quetzalcoatl Leija Herrera alive. Other members of the LGBT community have also been sought for questioning, including previous partners of Quetzalcoatl Leija Herrera.

While it is vital for the authorities to follow all leads, similar cases which have occurred in other parts of Mexico have sometimes resulted in police and prosecutors focusing solely on the personal relations of the victim rather than investigating possible homophobic motives for the attack.

Because we believe that Leija Herrera's murder may be related to his work at CEPRODEHI and that other members of the staff may be at risk of attack, we **strongly urge** that you

- provide other members of CEPRODEHI and LGBT rights activists in Chilpancingo protection, in accordance with their wishes;
- begin a full, impartial and prompt investigation of Quetzalcoatl Leija Herrera's killing and fully investigate all leads that might suggest a homophobic motive for the attack;
- support and provide protection to the organizers of the Gay Pride march, which will take place in memory of Quetzalcoatl Leija Herrera in June 2011.
